- Students will not be able to register if they have not provided updated proof of Liability Insurance or Protection of Minors Certificate. Make sure the counseling office has your updated proof of coverage and Certificate of Completion for your Protection of Minors so that your hold can be removed before registration begins.

- Counseling classes are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. To ensure you get the class you want, register *EARLY*. Classes are generally limited to a maximum of 14; however, some classes are limited to a smaller class size. Do not contact an instructor or advisor to ask permission to be added to a full class. Students should be using the waitlist system through my.smu. Waitlist information can be found in the Registration Information below.
- Practicum and Internship students will be enrolled in their respective Practicum and Internship classes by the Program Specialist, once class lists are received from Dr. Godhwani and Dr. Schumann.
- Make sure to order your SMU ID card, if you have not already done so.

<u>NEW STUDENTS:</u> Registrations for Fall Term 2025 opens at <u>Midnight on Saturday, April</u> 19 Instructions 1 through 10 below explain how to register online and they apply to ALL students.

- 1. Go to my.SMU enter your ID number and password
- 2. The term is Fall 1257.
- 3. Use the <u>Class Number</u> (the numbers in <u>ORANGE</u> above in the middle column)
- 4. You must enroll in at least two (2) classes to qualify for financial aid. Students using financial aid must contact the Financial Aid office.
- 5. The **results page** will let you know whether your course enrollment was successful.
- 6. If you get a message of "**errors found**," click on that message to read the specific problem. If you cannot resolve the error(s), please contact help@smu.edu. Include your SMU ID number.
- 7. Familiarize yourself with the Program Calendar and all add/drop deadline dates and refund policies.

ENROLLMENT GUIDANCE FOR NEW STUDENTS:

Welcome FIRST TERM Counseling Graduate Students!

Following is some information to help you with your first registration:

- If you are a new student, you are required to take the following courses during your first term in the program:
 - 1) Basic Clinical Methods
 - 2) Life Span Development
- If you can only take one course in the first term, you must enroll in Basic Clinical Methods (please note, you will not be eligible for financial aid if you take only one course).
- If you are planning on taking 3 classes (9 credit hours), the following classes are recommended to take in your first semester or as close to the start of the program as possible: COUNSELING THEORIES and RESEARCH DESIGN. Other classes can be taken at any time (unless there is a pre-req) throughout the program. Good ones to take are: FAMILY THERAPY I, ETHICS I, ADULT PSYCHOPATHOLOGY, DIVERSE COMMUNITIES or any of your ELECTIVES.
- <u>ALL</u> students <u>entering</u> the Counseling Program in the Fall 2025 semester are required to attend a Group Advising /Orientation Meeting on Monday, August 18th from 5:30 pm to 9:00 pm. At this meeting, we will review relevant policies, procedures, curriculum, and support resources. Watch for future emails regarding the location of this meeting. If you do not attend this meeting, you will not be able to register for the following semester so please make the necessary arrangements to attend in person.
